ABRAHAMSON—Dilworth, Minn. Tech. 5th gr. Lyle Abrahamson, 28, son of Mr. and Mrs. C. M.

Abrahamson of Dilworth, Minn., and whose wife, and son, Jerome, 2, reside with her father, E. J. Larson of Dilworth, died Dec. 25, 1944, in Belgium, of wounds received the previous day, while serving with the Seventh army. In



service since September, 1942, he trained at Camp Wolters, Texas, Camp Blanding, Fla., and Camp Atterbury, Ind., going overseas in February, 1944. He served in England, France, Netherlands and Germany in addition to Belgium. Wounded Sept. 24, 1944, he remained in action, later being awarded the Purple Heart. He also held the Good Conduct Medal and the Combat Infantryman Badge.
